he would do on the budget and on the dividend, and a majority of Alaskans voted for him on that basis. He deserves praise for having the guts to offer a balanced budget.

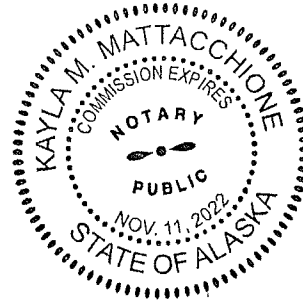
